<u>Cascade Co-ops benefits from NWCDC Grant!</u> The NWCDC offered CC a partnership for co-op trainings and in return CC is getting a \$7500 of their grant monies!!!

CC has not received payment yet.

Repayment for Marketing Costs

- CC has some outstanding debts for repayment of Marketing Costs to Deborah.
- Kris suggests that CC pay the marketing costs back to Deborah in full.
- CC owes Deborah \$1000 for Fall 2022 marketing ad in Cascadia Weekly
 - o Only 3 of our co-ops contributed to the marketing efforts: Circle of Life, ICU, and A-!.
- Need to wait for vote from Michael M.- Add to next meeting agenda.

Newsletter/ Marketing Question: "Mailer light" program could be used to save us some money.

- Ashanti has used this program and it is inexpensive and user friendly and accessible.
- Save money and has lots of resources

October Event Planning: The group briefly discussed options for the October event.

- It is important that planning starts as soon as possible, so we have time for marketing and engaging the co-ops.
- We could do a "Meet the Cascade Co-ops event" and everyone could set up their marketing tables.
- Contact Paul Schlisser to discuss the possibility of a joint sponsored co-op housing event in October.
- Add to next meeting agenda.

International Co-op Day on July 3: Ashanti inquired about participation in global co-op day. July 1-First Sat in July.

- CC could consider inviting co-ops to a meet and greet.
- Co-op's could each have a table at the event.
- We could supply the co-ops yard signs "Happy International Day of Cooperatives"
 - o Yard signs could be supplied to the CC coops and put up at Farm Markets
 - o Parking spaces at ICU? We could do a CC table.
 - o Pop up tent, folding tables, Camp chairs.
 - o Ashanti can volunteer to update the Marketing materials.
- There isn't much time for planning, but this could be a great idea for upcoming years.
- We could do a table at the farmers market to highlight the event this year.
 - o ICU may let us use the parking lot at State and Chestnut.
 - o It is too late to get a table spot at the market.
 - o We could set up a table on the sidewalk outside of the market on July 1.
